Disney Art

Eric Carle Art

Gain appreciation for the work of Eric Carle not only as a story writer, but as an illustrator. We will create our own original Eric Carle creation through paper collage art, stamp printing, texture, repetition, different types of paper, depth, templates and shapes. Join this fun and exciting class. (Grades 2-3)

Healthy Living

Tasty, good nutrition, proper care of our teeth, bike safety, environmental care, are just a few of the topics that will be covered in this class. Come ready to learn life-long good habits to share with your family and friends. (Grades 2-3)

Invasion Games

Do you know what an "Invasion Game" is? Come join us as we play soccer, floor hockey, flicker ball, tag, capture the flag, and many more team games. Only requirement is that you are a good sport!!! (Grades 2-7)

Self-Defense

(24A1, 24A2, 5A3, 34Ba, 34B2, 55B3, 55B3)

This class includes aspects from a number of different martial arts: karate, tai chi, tai qwon do, and perhaps a little judo thrown in as well. Students will learn proper stances, how to move, strikes, blocks, and kicks. Practice will include the use of pads and other equipment. Join the fun as we explore what kinds of materials were available and used in the past by the Native Americans. You will create a variety of Native American art and writing using their symbols and natural materials. (Grades 4-7)

Who says writing poems has to be hard? Join us and learn how easy and fun poetry can be! We will have a poetry race, do rhyme-time riddles, and learn how to write a Cinquain poem as well as much, much more. (Grades 2-3)

Re-use, Re-cycle

Come learn the importance of re-cycling while reusing ordinary, household items to make fun crafts. We will make flower vases, and bird feeders just to name a few. Save your peanut butter jars, mild cartons, old jeans, used wrapping paper, cereal boxes, shoe boxes, newspapers, and 2 liter plastic bottles. (Grades 2-3)

Enjoy a variety of activities with one thing in common....WATER! A swim suit (or change of clothes) and a towel should be brought to class each day - you will get wet. (Grades 2-7)

"I'm bored, there's nothing to do!!" How many times have you said this??? Come learn crafts, games, experiments and activities that can be done anytime alone or with a friend or two. Everything we do uses items already found in your home, and best of all, NO Batteries are needed!!!
