Classroom Technology

- All of the 9th and 10th grade laptops were finished, but we were just notified that the version of office we installed needs to change from Office 2013 to Office 2016 for the state vocational program. We were originally told it had to be Office 2013. It will take us a few weeks to complete that upgrade.
- Several carts of new iPads have also been received this summer, setup, and delivered to the schools with several more still expected to arrive.

Security/Video

- We will be installing cameras in the entryways at Minico during the first couple weeks of August. We are also working with the Maintenance Department to install new locks at the District Service Center.

West/Paul Phones

- West and Paul are both having new phones installed the first part of August. With the completion of West and Paul all the extensions will be able to communicate with each other on one system.

Online Registration

- Online registration will start the second week of August and will run until the first day of school. Parents always have the option of going to the school on the registration days if they prefer. For Elementary Students, online registration can be done, but the majority of the parents do not know the PowerSchool login to start. Their PowerSchool logins will be given to them at this year's manual registration.

Summer School

- All of the summer school equipment has been put back to their original location. There were several carts of laptops and iPads that were moved to summer school for them to use.

I was able to work with programmers and add more customizations and plan for enhancements coming in the next year.
