Subject: Consider Approval of Renewal of Contract 2009.508 for Phonoscope Education Network, Inc.				
Background: On January 26, 2009 Contract 2009.508 was awarded by the Board of Trustees to Phonoscope Education Network, Inc., as an internet services and support provider. The three (3) year term contract began on July 1, 2009 with monthly costs of approximately \$7,200.00. As an approved ILA HCDE supplier, Phonoscope is able to offer a discounted pricing structure for high speed internet access. At the time of the initial award, our estimate of the contract value was based on projected higher bandwidth useage (1G vs. current usage of 225 Mbps). Given the district's historical and projected internet usage is substantially lower than originally thought and giving full consideration to the addition of two new campuses coming online in the Fall of 2010, the Technology Department calculates a total contract value of \$500,000.00 versus \$1,000,000.00 It is the recommendation of the purchasing Director and the Chief Technology Office to renew the subject contract in the amount of \$500,000.00.
