Board Member Qualifications

A person is eligible to serve as a Board member if ~~he/she~~ **the person** is an **qualified** elector¹ of the district and has ~~An “elector” means an individual qualified to vote under Section 2, Article II of the Oregon Constitution. The individual must be 18 years of age or older, registered to vote at least 20 calendar days immediately preceding any elections in the manner provided by law and must have been a resident within the district for one year immediately preceding the election or appointment. If the district and the position sought is one elected or nominated by zone, the person must also reside in the zone from which the person is nominated except as authorized by law.~~

During the fulfillment of their duties as a board member, board members who have not successfully passed the district volunteer background check may not be in schools where students are present unless they are accompanied by a district or building administrator.

~~No~~ **A** person who is an employee of the district is **not** eligible to serve as a Board member while so employed.

A person who is an employee of a public charter school may not serve as a member of the Board of the district in which the public charter school that employs the person is located.

The district discourages Board members from serving on the Board of a charter school due to conflicts of interest that may arise.
