Dear Board Members,

Attached you will find one document:

1. The ACT School Report for Tupelo High School (this report is identical to the ACT District Report which I did not include)

This report shows (a) a five-year trend comparison to the state average; (b) the percent of students ready for college-level coursework; (c) the average ACT math scores by course progression and (d) the average ACT science scores by course progression.

Tupelo High School/Tupelo Public School District had .04% higher Composite Score Average than the State Composite Average. Please refer to the Five Year Trend Table.

According to the ACT National 2018 Report, there is concern for the drop in performance in math and reading. The results include more than 1.9 million 2018 graduates (55 percent of the national graduating class) who took the ACT. The link to this report is provide if you are interested.
