Summary:	The rubberized playground surfacing at Cannon Elementary School and Timberline Elementary School must be resealed every few years to ensure its useful life of more than fifteen year and its effectiveness. Resealing is due for these sites and is not possible through the District's operating budget. The estimated cost is \$60,000. The career and technical education (CTE) department will be working to write in-house curriculum for several of its unique courses. However, an appropriation for curriculum is still needed to continue these long-term programs for students. The estimated cost is \$138,587.
