The following revision was made to the BHS and Phoenix Handbooks:

• POST SECONDARY ENROLLMENT OPTIONS ACT

All public school 11th and 12th grade students are eligible to participate in this program. The purpose of the program is to promote rigorous educational pursuits and provide a wider variety of options to high school student by enabling 11th and 12th graders to enroll full-time or part-time, without cost to them, in a non-sectarian course or program in any eligible Minnesota post-secondary institutions. PSEO students are allowed on campus only with prior approval. Part time PSEO students are expected to complete coursework off campus and are only on campus during BHS classes.
