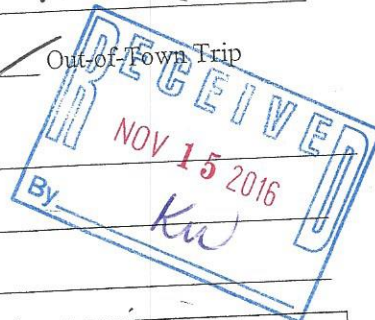

St. Louis, MO. Educational Rationale for Brooks Middle School (11-8-16)

Brooks students will be able to explore the Cahokia Mounds Historic Site to learn about the Native American culture, visit Harris Stowe State University to gain exposure to the academic expectations needed for College and Career Readiness, and visit the Gateway Arch to learn about St. Louis' role in assisting the settlers as they migrated westward many years ago.

St. Louis, MO

Cahokia Mounds State Historic Site – The remains of the most sophisticated prehistoric native civilization north of Mexico are preserved at Cahokia Mounds State Historic Site. Within the 2,200-acre tract, located a few miles west of Collinsville, Illinois, lie the archaeological remnants of the central section of the ancient settlement that is today known as Cahokia. One of the greatest cities of the world, Cahokia was larger than London was in AD 1250. The Mississippians who lived here were accomplished builders who erected a wide variety of structures from practical homes for everyday living to monumental public works that have maintained their grandeur for centuries.
