RECOMMENDATION #1 CERTIFIED SUBSTITUTES SUBSTITUTING IN CONTENT AREA

"Option 1"	Pay scale remains the same -Substitutes are paid the amount noted above on day 1	
"Option 2"	Substitutes are paid amount noted above after 20 consecutive days in the same assignment** & Paid the following rate if less than 20 days or work non-consecutively -\$100/day for less than 15yrs -\$115/day for more than 15yrs	
"Option 3"	Pay the same amount as Bridge City ISD -After the 21st day they get \$197.86/day	

Note: Long-term assignment**= 20 consecutive full school days in the same assignment. A school day shall be at least seven (7) hours each day, including intermissions and recesses. (EC Legal). Long term substitute teacher pay shall not be affected by a district-wide early release day. On the 21st day pay increases and is retroactive to the beginning of assignment.
