- 1. Title I and State Compensatory Education** –Currently we have 257 students who qualified for this program. This number drives our funding for Title 1 and SCE.
- 2. Discipline** – We had two HS students assigned to DAEP for 13 days. Both students' last day in DAEP was February 2nd. They are back in class.
- 3. PSLA and Instructional Leaders Advisory Committee** – On February 4th, I attended these two meetings at the ESC.
- 4. School Improvement Webinar** - On February 5th I participated in a webinar hosted at the region center on time on task – teaching bell to bell.
- 5. SHARS Training** – Sunray has to have a trained SHARS person. SHARS is a federal reimbursement program for students who have special needs and qualify for health related services. On February 12, I participated in the 6 hour training webinar.
