- 1. Employability Skills Guest Speakers: Mrs. Huseby (Guidance) and Mrs. Vandenberg (8th grade ELA teacher), organized guest speakers Steve Daigle from Daigle Brothers inc., Michelle Mork from Trigs, Kris Berg from The Windmill Ice Cream Shoppe, and a representative from the Human Resources Department at Church Mutual on Tuesday, January 22nd to discuss employability skills with our 8th grade students.
