Changes from Last Year:

- Page 18- Clarified testing procedures
- Page 31- Clarified PBIS referral follow-up by counselors within 24 hours.
- Page 43- Changed location of bike racks (this was done 2 years ago but I missed it)

The Junior-Senior High Handbook has a few more significant changes. They are listed below:

- Technology Use Deleted as it appears in the laptop materials.
- Food and Drink Limited to the Student Center and not allowed in classrooms.
- Concurrent Classes Students will be assigned a study hall for the college class.
- Response to Intervention Deleted.
- Distance Learning Deleted as it pertains to remote instruction during the pandemic.
