



ETHNICITY




Comparison of DISD Reports of Post Graduate Plans with Current Status Reported at 18 Month Survey

Observations-----Implications

- Rate of Return needs to be increased
- Revise Questions
- Work/College Planning
- Campus Review of Data

- Enlist student leaders & brief parents
- Ensure that information gathered is usable
- Help students create back up plans
- Utilize data for goal setting and planning & maintain awareness of student perception of services

Conclusions

- Denton ISD High Schools did an Excellent to Good job with our students as confirmed by the Graduates of the Class of 2007 in the 18 month post graduation survey.
- The data appears to be consistent with the original exit survey and provides a baseline to use in comparing our progress with future 18 month surveys of our subsequent Life Track Classes.
- With district growth and improving technological resources, we should investigate the possibilities of moving to an "in-house" survey process.
