Elevating Student Voice



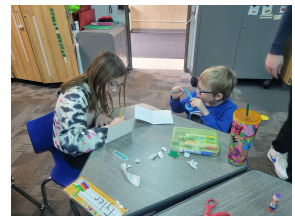
- Morning Meetings – daily
