DESCRIPTION:

The Community Education (CE) team programmed a wide range of activities and services this summer. Once again, we will have the remedial reading and math Targeted Services (TS) program. These classes are taught by BHM District teachers and are free of charge to in-district children who are referred by their classroom teachers.

The program is funded by Targeted Services dollars along with additional federal funds from MDE. We currently have 431 students referred to the TS program, down from 532 in 2021. We are planning for centralized transportation from each of the District elementary schools and with the additional funding we will have additional stops at two child care centers and the mobile home parks in Montrose and Buffalo.

The TS program will be located at the Tatanka Elementary STEM School (TESS) (per the 4-year building rotation cycle), June 20 through July 28, Monday-Thursday, 8:30-11:30 a.m.

Summer Sun Block is also part of the summer school programs. Sun Block offers a wide variety of classes to choose from. It is held at the same time as TS classes and open to all students in grades 2-7.

KidKare will have sites open in HES and MESI and all Buffalo sites will be combined at TESS. KidKare students participate in the Sun Block or TS program as part of their day.

The USDA Summer Food Program will be offered at TESS and DES and will be dine in. All students in summer programs will have access to free breakfast and lunch. The program will be available to all children 18 and under in the community.

In addition to Sun Block, TS and KidKare, Community Education continues to offer a wide variety activities and events for children and adults in the BHM community. Below is a list of examples of the opportunities planned for this summer:

- ECFE- 6 Concert in the Park events
- ECFE- 6 Stay & Play
- STEAM Camp- 8 Session Kindergarten Readiness Camp at DES

- School Readiness- Summer Sun Pre-School/4 days a week at DES and MEEC
- Early Childhood Screening – 5 days DES
- Youth Recreation- camps: tennis, football, basketball, volleyball, gymnastics
- Youth Enrichment classes- Poetry in the Park, Social Emotional Learning, Orchestra camp, Drone photography, Engineering
- Swim lessons- BCMS pool and Pulaski Beach
- High School Driver Education – Classroom June & July (MESI, HES, BHS)
- Drivers Ed Parent Child Safety Night- June 28 at BHS
- Adult Enrichment – Theatre trips, State Fair, Wellness classes, Warren Commission
- Adults with Disabilities –Bison Fishing Forever trips, Bingo, Demo Derby Night
- Adult Basic Education- ESL and GED evening and day time classes
