Welcome back Evergreen Students, Staff, and Parents,

Hopefully everyone had a fantastic Winter Holiday enjoying some quality time with your family and friends. Where has the time gone, it feels like it was just the first day of school yesterday.

As the New Year kicks off, I just want to remind parents that good attendance is key to academic success, especially with state testing for our  $3^{rd}$ ,  $4^{th}$ , and  $5^{th}$  graders starting at the end of January. The lower grades will continue to focus on individual student growth in reading, math, and writing. This year for OAKS state testing, the  $3-5^{th}$  grade students will be only allowed two times to take the Reading and Math tests in the computer lab. The  $5^{th}$  graders will also be taking a Science test for the state. This is a change from previous years, where students were allowed to take the test up to three times. The first round is expected to start at the end of January into February. The second round will begin in the middle of April and finish up in May. It is imperative that all students continue to eat well, maintain regular attendance, and get adequate sleep during the week. Parents please continue to support your child by communicating with your teacher on a regular basis about their behavior and academic growth.


