Subject:	Consider and Approve a Collaboration and Course License Agreement with the Florida Virtual School

Summary:	<p>GCISD has worked with the Florida Virtual School (FLVS) in the past to purchase their online courses for use in our virtual school. The FLVS uses the name FlexPoint Education Cloud (FlexPoint) to offer virtual courses to third parties. Over the past several months, GCISD and FlexPoint have negotiated a License Agreement for FlexPoint to exclusively market and sell GCISD TEKS aligned online courses in the State of Texas. The agreement initially involves 11 courses delivered by GCISD to work in specific learning management systems and meeting other requirements. GCISD would receive remuneration from the sale of course licenses sold through three FLVS license models.</p> <p>The term of the License Agreement is one year with the ability of the parties to mutually renew it after one year.</p> <p>The License Agreement is attached and has been reviewed by Mike Leasor, the District's legal counsel and the above-listed District employees. The 30-page agreement outlines many</p>

aspects of GCISD's obligations and responsibilities. The Service Level Agreement, which defines GCISD's support of the courses, is more specifically detailed in Attachment 1a and in the Warranties Section 12 of the License Agreement. Remuneration from licensing models is also found in Attachment 1a.

The purpose of the License Agreement is to provide revenue for the District by using its intellectual property that it created for its virtual school after having revised it for these commercial purposes. The District will monitor the time, effort, and cost to support the initial 11 courses for the first year.
