#### Teacher Tip by: Howie Daggs, CLC Teacher

This month I thought I would share a fun technique called Role-Reversal or Teaching Others. When finishing a unit or when you want to check your student's understanding, try switching it up and become the student yourself while your student is the teacher! With this role reversal you can get a unique perspective on what they know and understand. With students having to teach the material, you will see a shift in their processing as they explain the lesson. In some other sources I found, they saw retention of the given topic increase to 90%. (Kelly, 2012). Not only does this give you an informal assessment of how they are doing, but it allows students to think about the topic in another way while greatly increasing retention of the material.

Another benefit to this fun exercise is that the student playing the teacher can gain some insight as to what its like for you to teach them. Hopefully students can empathize with you on what you do and the effort you put into teaching them.

So, get creative with this fun way to divert from the normal routine and play teacher for a day. You can ham up the student role and make them explain material while experiencing some of the behaviors they give you.


