### What is the Future-Ready Superintendents Leadership Network (FRSLN)?

Superintendent-designed and superintendent-led, the FRSLN is a group of school leaders who, with the help and support of TASA, gather for events that provide authentic learning experiences that help them expand their leadership beyond the local level and advance the vision of student-centered schools and future-ready students outlined in [Creating a New Vision for Public Education in Texas](#).

### Is the FRSLN new?

FRSLN was designed in 2015 to provide the members of the original Future-Ready Superintendents Leadership Institute (FRSLI) — 39 superintendents and senior-level district administrators in the early stages of their careers who met in 2012 — and other school leaders committed to [MISSION: School Transformation](#) with opportunities to build on their understanding of and initiate innovative systemic changes locally and statewide.

### May I bring others?

Each participating superintendent may invite up to two central office leaders from their districts.

### What's the cost?

Just \$595 per participating superintendent; central office leaders may attend for an additional \$495 each. Related travel costs are at districts' expense.

### How do I sign up for the 2016–17 FRSLN?

Tell the participating superintendent who shared this information with you that you're interested; they will forward your name to TASA, which will email you a formal invitation in early June. At that time, commit to attend at least three FRSLN events in 2016–17 and, if you like, nominate up to two central office leaders from your district to join you.

### What (and when) are the FRSLN events?

The 2016–17 FRSLN experience will include four events; we ask participating superintendents to commit to at least three. The four events include three Superintendent EdCamps and one visit to an innovative company — all held within Texas. The details are being worked out by the superintendents in charge, but the basic schedule looks like this:

<b>FRSLN EdCamp #1</b> October 2016 Hosted by Georgetown ISD	<b>FRSLN EdCamp #2</b> February 2017 Hosted by Sunnyvale & Royse City ISDs
<b>FRSLN Innovative Company Trip</b> January 2017 Hosted in San Antonio area	<b>FRSLN EdCamp #3</b> April 2017 Hosted by Lytle ISD

**Optional (Tentative) Event:** FRSLN organizers are considering an optional event — a trip to Milliken & Co. in South Carolina. Likely to occur in late fall 2016, the trip could serve as a fifth event or serve as one of the three required events for participants. More details will be available soon!
