MASB's 2015 Delegate Assembly will begin Thursday, Oct. 22 at 7:30 p.m. at the Grand Traverse Resort. Delegates selected by boards of education across the state will decide MASB's positions on a wide variety of issues affecting education, including our position on proposed legislation being considered by the State Board of Education.

Below is a link to use to certify the official voting delegates and alternates who will represent your board of education. All delegates and alternates must be school board members. Only delegates and alternates named by your board may offer motions and vote on issues. However, all school board members may speak on the issues and participate in the debate. Your 2015-2016 MASB dues must be paid in order for a district to participate in the Delegate Assembly. You'y

Delegates must register separately from the MASB Annual Leadership Conference registration and pick up their ribbons (which identify them as official voting delegates) outside the ballroom where the Delegate Assembly is meeting. Registration will open one hour prior to the Delegate Assembly. In order to register, your delegates and alternates must be certified by your board of education in advance of the Delegate Assembly. Voting delegates and alternates cannot be certified on-site. Please use the below link to certify your delegates. All delegates must be certified by Oct. 8.

Each school board that is an active or academy member of the Association is entitled to representation at an annual or special meeting, as follows:

Group I	All ISDs	1 Voting Delegate & Alternate
Group II	0-1,400	1 Voting Delegates & Alternates
Group III	1,401-2,500	2 Voting Delegates & Alternates
Group IV	2,501-5,000	3 Voting Delegates & Alternates
Group V	5,001-11,000	4 Voting Delegates & Alternates
Group VI	11,001-40,000	4 Voting Delegates & Alternates
Group VII	Over 40,000	4 Voting Delegates & Alternates

Each school board that is an active or academy member of the Association shall select its delegates and alternates ... and certify [them] to the executive director prior to the annual or special meeting.
