Bylaws of the Board

Officers

The New Fairfield Board of Education shall, no later than one month after the date of which the newly elected members take office, elect from its number a Chairperson, Vice Chairperson and Secretary of such Board for the ensuing two years and may prescribe their duties.

How Elected

Each voting Board member shall cast his/her vote for election of officers. The results of the election shall be recorded in the minutes of the meeting. If the Chairperson and the Secretary are not chosen after one month because of a tie vote of the members, the Board of Selectmen shall choose such officers from the membership of the Board. If the Vice-Chairperson is not chosen after one month because of a tie vote of the members, the Board of Selectmen may choose this officer from the membership of the Board.
