The Minnesota Department of Education released the Multiple Measurements Rating (MMR) School Accountability results on October 1st. The Becker Schools scored among the top in the state.

The Becker Middle School ranked 2nd in the state out of 225 middle schools placing at the 99th percentile. The Intermediate School placed at the 74th percentile and earned eligibility as a “celebration school”. The High School placed in the top third of Minnesota’s high schools at the 67th percentile. Dr. Malone, Becker School Superintendent, said “the entire school district is very proud of the outstanding performance of our students and staff members.”

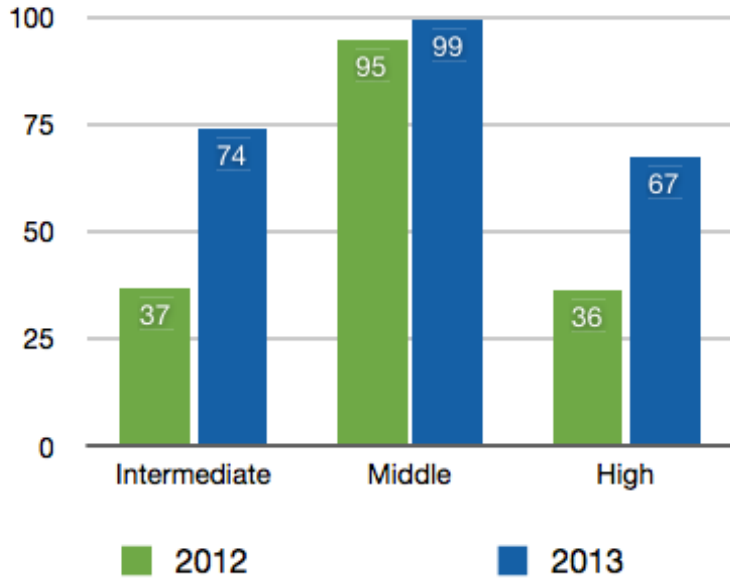
The Becker Schools dramatically increased their MMR scores and percentile rankings in comparison to last year. The Intermediate School doubled its percentile ranking from 37th to 74th. The High School nearly doubled its ranking from 36th to 67th. The Middle School moved from 12th to 2nd in the state increasing its percentile rank from 95th to 99th.

The MMR measures math and reading scores for grades 3-11. The score includes several components: proficiency (points based on students and subgroups that make Adequate Yearly Progress – AYP), growth (students’ predicted to actual academic growth), achievement gap reduction (the academic growth of seven subgroups), and graduation rate.

Superintendent Malone attributed the improved test scores to the work of teachers and administrators in six key areas:

- Aligning the curriculum to state standards
- Identifying essential learning outcomes
- Developing rigorous and common assessments
- Using a research-based instructional model
- The Response to Intervention programs
- Using technology to improve instruction and curriculum content

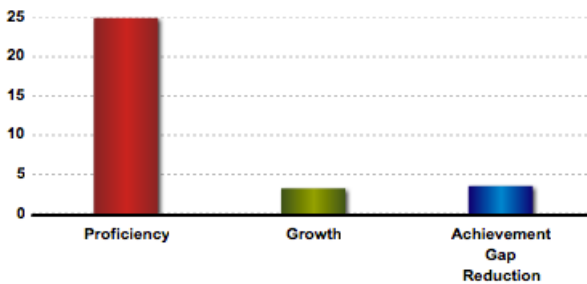

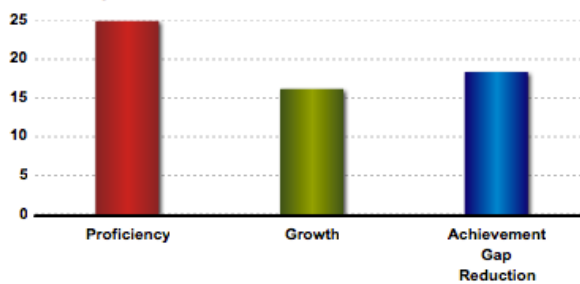
2012 Multiple Measurement Domains

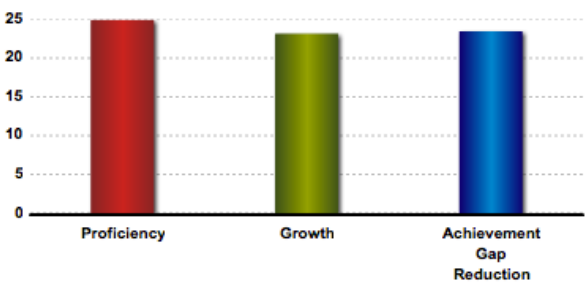

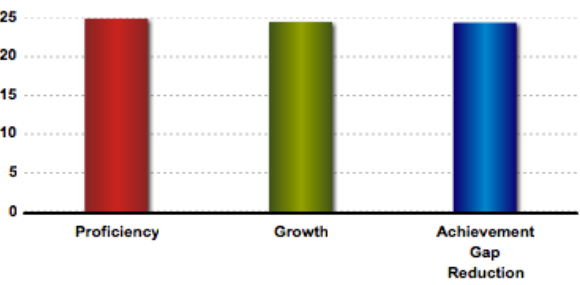
2012 Multiple Measurement Domains

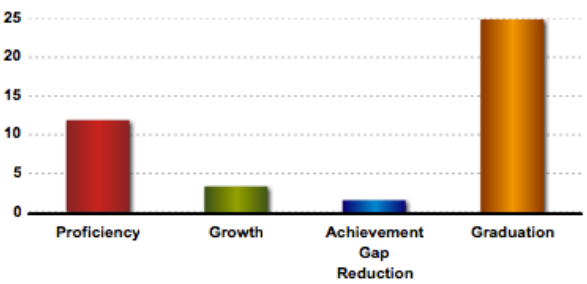
