# House Bill 3 and CCMR

CCMR means equipping students with the knowledge, skills, and experiences necessary to succeed in **college**, enter a meaningful **career**, or serve confidently in the **military**.



# College Readiness

- ACT: English and Reading 40 and Math 22  
SAT: English 480 Math 530
- TSIA2: Reading 945 Essay higher than a score of 5  
TSIA2: Math 950
- Advanced Placement Exams (AP): Any Subject Area Exam with a 3 or higher
- Associates Degree: Earned prior to graduation (Collegiate Academy)
- Dual Credit: 3 Hours in ELA or Math or 9 Hours in any other subject
- College Prep Course for both English and Math
- IEP Graduate with Workforce Readiness



# Career Readiness

- 2024-25
  - 2 or more CTE Courses for 3 or more credits in the same program of study with a earned approved Industry-Based Certification (IBC)
- 2025-26
  - 3 or more CTE Courses for 4 or more credits in the same program of study with an earned approved Industry-Based Certification (IBC)

# Military Readiness

Students can earn a CCMR point through verified military enlistment, with 1–3% of our graduates typically pursuing this pathway each year, as reported to TEA by the Department of Defense.
