## HYDABURG CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT Resolution 2017-02

**WHEREAS**, the Hydaburg City School District (HCSD) is continually striving to upgrade the quality and efficiency of the District's facilities; AND

**WHEREAS**, the lighting currently in the Hydaburg School Gym does not provide adequate illumination for events and does not provide the level of energy efficiency desired by the District; AND

**WHEREAS**, the HCSD has the opportunity to apply for a grant through the Alaska Housing Finance Corporation called the Energy Efficiency Kickstarter Competitive Award; AND

**WHEREAS**, the HCSD proposal for this grant would replace the gym lights with energy-efficient LED lights; AND

**WHEREAS,** the Energy Efficiency Kickstarter Competitive Award, if awarded, would provided up to \$10,000 in funding for this project; AND

**WHEREAS,** any reductions in utility bills that results from installation of these lights could be used for other purposes, such as instruction of students.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:** The Hydaburg City School Board of Education authorizes the Hydaburg City School District Administration, through Superintendent Lauren Burch, to apply for the Energy Efficiency Kickstarter Competitive Award from the Alaska Housing Finance Corporation.
