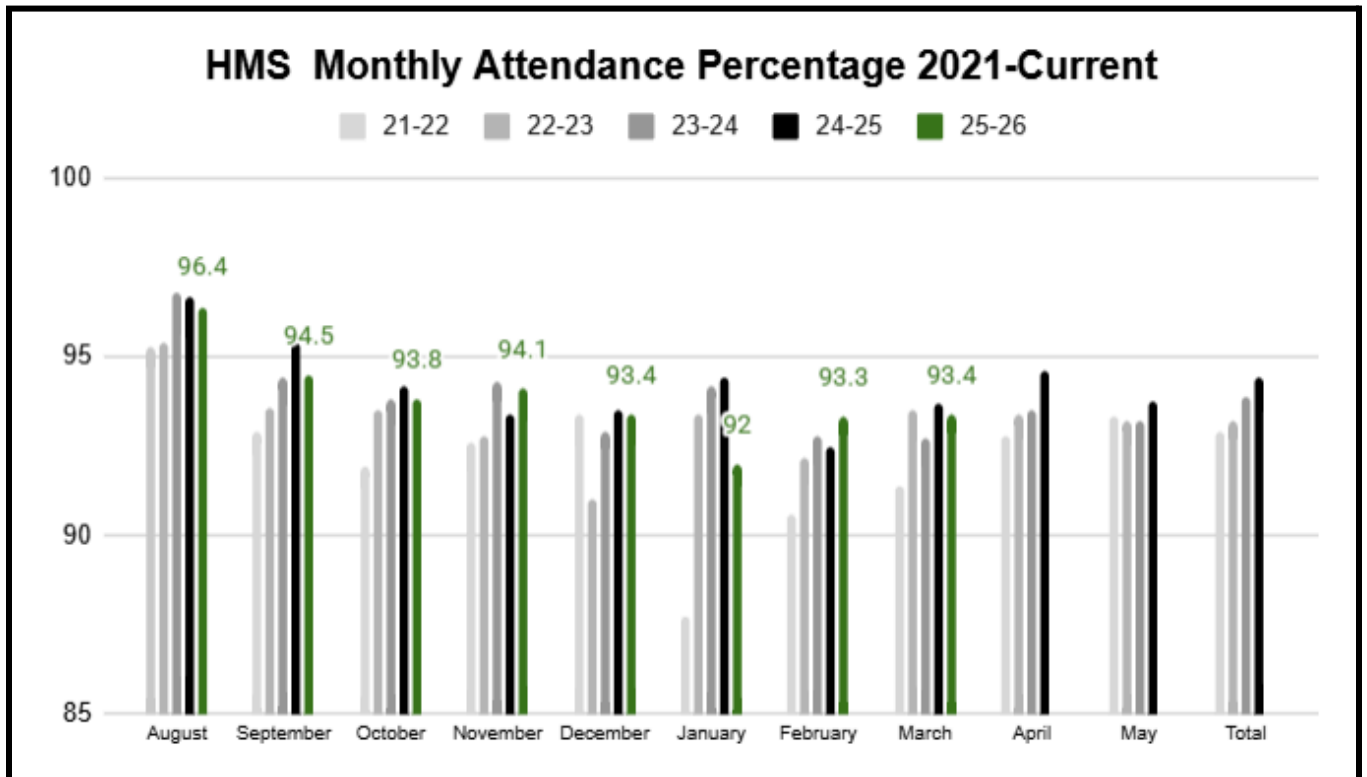
Enrollment

Total: 393

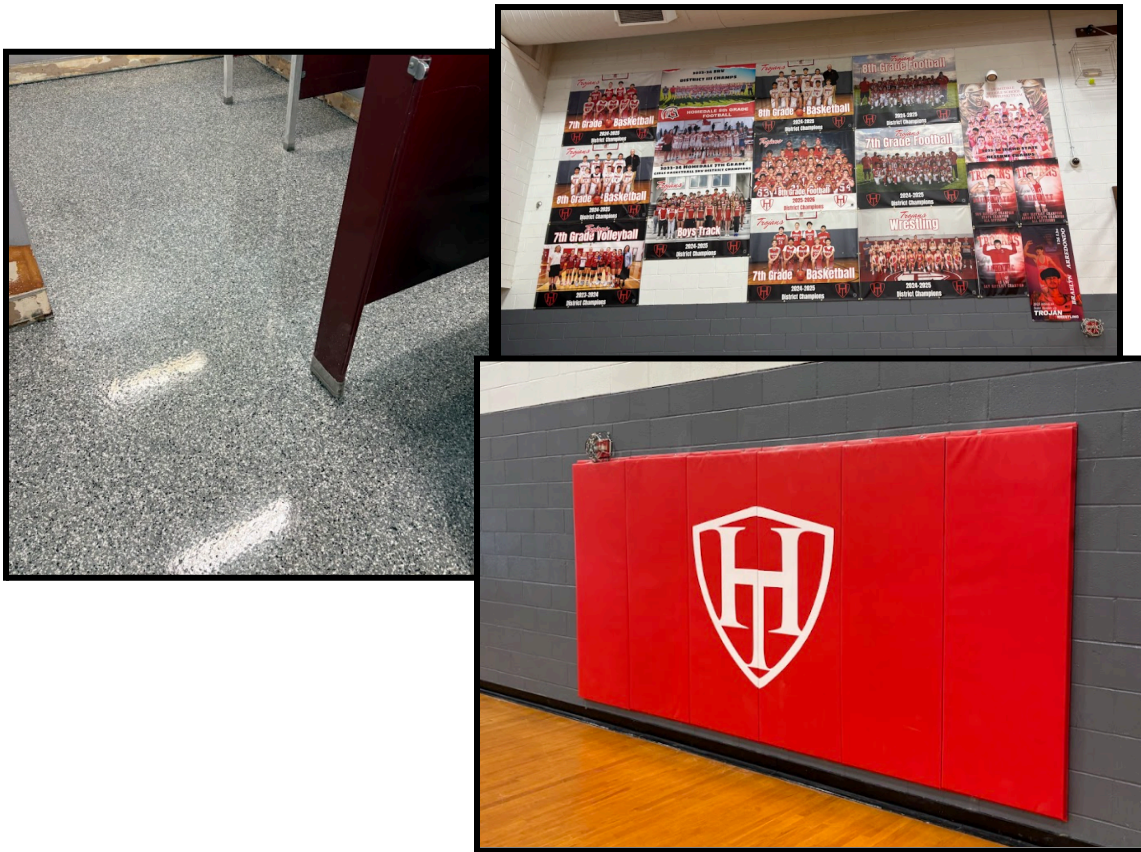
Attendance:
