Subject: Consider Approval of School Resource Officers – City of Carrollton, City of The Colony, City of Highland Village, City of Lewisville, Town of Flower Mound

Background Information:

- School Resource Officers (SROs) have been an integral part of the Safety and Security programs at Lewisville ISD campuses for many years.
- SRO programs support the common public interest of Lewisville ISD and the respective municipalities by addressing juvenile delinquency, developing positive relations between students and law enforcement, and supporting a safe and secure learning environment.
- Current SRO allocation by municipality:
 - City of Carrollton – 5 SROs and a portion of 1 Sergeant
 - City of Highland Village – 2 SROs
 - City of Lewisville – 10 SROs and a portion of 1 Sergeant
 - City of The Colony – 5 SROs and a portion of 1 Sergeant
 - Town of Flower Mound – 11 SROs, a portion of 2 Sergeants, and a portion of 1 Lieutenant

Administrative Consideration:

- Funds for this service come from the Safety and Security Department budget(s).
- Previous annual expenditures:
 - 2025–2026: \$3,551,176
- Estimated annual expenditures: \$3,657,711 but will not exceed the approved budget.
- LISD has been working with our municipal partners, many of which are dealing with a nationwide shortage of law enforcement officers to increase SRO coverage when possible. Lewisville has indicated that LISD's request should be met this fiscal year.
- This procurement complies with Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code.

Recommendations:

- That the Lewisville ISD Board of Trustees approves the continued use of local law enforcement agencies for School Resource Officers and the estimated annual expenditures for the 2026–2027 school year with the City of Carrollton, the City of The Colony, the City of Highland Village, the City of Lewisville, and the Town of Flower Mound
