Two students have recently moved into our district that were previously identified as Special Education and 3 migrant students that are Special Education have also enrolled. Several speech only students have been dismissed.

The PBMAS data has been received and our district has moved from a 1B to a 2 in the TEA rating system. We scored a 3 on the LEP Special Education indicator as well as Special Education Identification and Special Education Hispanic Representation. These scores are based on the October 2005 PEIMS information. At that time our Special Education Identification was 100 and is currently at 81. While we will have to complete TEA's PBMAS report we are improving on our numbers which will be in the report disseminated in the fall of 2007.

Admission Review or Dismissal (ARD) meetings are held at least once per year for each student. If all ARD members including the parent agree a child can be dismissed from Special Education at the ARD meeting if appropriate.
