COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

Catholic Charities, Diocese of Joliet Early Childhood Services Division operates Head Start and Early Head Start programs in Will County, providing continuous, comprehensive child development, child care and family support services to families with children from six weeks to five years old and to pregnant women. Priority is given to families with incomes at or below the United States Department of Health and Human Services Poverty Guidelines. Head Start and Early Head Start are not-for-profit and federally funded, with child care supported by state funds.

The Early Childhood Services Division seeks to partner with other community agencies in the development of a coordinated network of services in order to facilitate access and enhance services provided to children and families.

BE IT THEREFORE AGREED UPON THAT

CATHOLIC CHARITIES EARLY CHILDHOOD SERVICES DIVISION AND

JOLIET TOWNSHIP HIGH SCHOOL, DISTRICT 204

- 1) Recognize the existence of their respective professional services.
- 2) Maintain regular contact, including community assessment, and involvement in program planning and evaluation where beneficial to families.
- 3) Assist in providing necessary resources, services and client information with the use of appropriate release of information forms to protect client confidentiality.
- 4) Acquaint clients and families who may have need of the other's services
- 5) Generally uphold ongoing cooperative planning, resources development and service delivery system to support families, promote strengths and meet social service needs within the community.
- 6) Coordinate efforts to recruit and identify families that will benefit from enrollment into each other's program services.

This agreement is non-financial and will be reviewed annually or as needed to determine if modifications are necessary. This agreement may be renewed in three years and may be cancelled in writing by either party provided 30 days' notice is given prior to termination of agreement.
