Custodial crew


Teachers


Results: 199 responses to survey

Summary of Comments (54 comments)

27 responses commenting on the desire for additional time when the weather is warm for family vacations and summer fun (this includes some families who also have LPHS students)

3 responses want to ensure Winter and Spring Break are aligned with LPHS (this has been our practice and will continue)

7 responses prefer August 27 or after Labor Day to start the school year (If students began on Labor Day this year, our last day without snow days would be 6/16)

8 comments specifically mention wanting to match LPHS

5 comments ask about camps/childcare options with the later start

1 comment referenced the difficulty of SMART Day dismissal times not lining up with LPHS

1 comment expressing a desire to end school before Memorial Day
