I. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

A. <u>Legislative Report:</u>

- 1. Adair v State of Michigan Status Report: Supt. Glaes reviewed a letter from Attorney Dennis Pollard regarding the legislative commission on statutory mandates, which stated that the commission's reform bills have had positive acceptance in Lansing. The importance of municipalities and school districts encouraging the legislature to move responsibly in paying for mandated actions was stressed.
- 2. <u>MASA Update:</u> Supt. Glaes stated that Michigan did not receive RTTT grant funding. Mr. Glaes also stated that the retirement rate has increased 2.5% for 2011. Other legislative topics were discussed.
- B. <u>Review of Ballot for May 4, 2010:</u> Supt. Glaes stated that there are two candidates for May 4, 2010:
 - 1. School Board Candidates
 - a. Chris Armitage
 - b. Tom Danielson
- C. <u>Important Dates:</u> Supt. Glaes referred to listing of important dates. Mrs. Lohman gave a preview of the Middle School Science Night and encouraged everyone to attend.
- D. <u>Survey Results:</u> Supt. Glaes gave a summary of the District budget survey. The District is committed to maintaining the tradition of excellence in all buildings and will make the best decisions possible to keep money in the classrooms and the focus on students. The budget must be approved by June 30.

B. Business and Finance Report - Steve Goss:

- 1. Budget Progress Report for Month Ending February 28, 2010: Asst. Supt. Goss reviewed the budget progress report for February 2010 showing total revenues of \$10,418,156; total expenditures of \$12,278,091; and deficiency of revenues over expenditures of -\$1,859,935. Mr. Goss stated that the District is committed to making cuts, but doing so in a way that maintains the District's attractiveness. Administrative costs have been reduced and will continue to be reduced. Salaries and benefits total over 80% of the District budget.
- 3. <u>2010 2011 Bus Purchase Recommendation Ric Beers:</u> Mr. Beers recommended that the Board approve the purchase of two 77 passenger buses. The District's policy is to replace three buses per year which keeps a bus fleet no more than 10-11 years.

C. Professional Development Report:

- 1. <u>Professional Development Annual Report Pat Wilson O'Leary:</u> Mrs. Wilson O'Leary presented her annual report including professional development for teachers and administrators in the Vicksburg Community Schools as well as outside districts.
- 2. <u>2009-10 District Professional Development Days Update Charles Glaes:</u> Supt. Glaes referred to a listing of professional development days and topics targeted to building goals and school improvement needs.

D. Instructional Report

- 1. Indian lake 2010 MEAP and School Improvement Report Rick Szabla: Mr. Szabla presented the "Indian Lake MEAP Story Continues, Getting Our Ducks in a Row! 2010" which showed that all test scores were between 90 and 100%. Ruth Hook described some of the District and Indian Lake initiatives.
- 2. Annual Curriculum/Program Proposals and Reports Charles Glaes:
 - a. <u>High School World Language Proposal STAMP Test for 8th Grade Competency.</u> First year cost of \$3,340.00; year two cost \$3,040.00; year three cost \$2,290.00; yearly cost after of \$2,290.00: Kay Anderson and Allie Lamers explained that the Michigan Merit Exam

requires two credits of language for the class of 2016. STAMP offers proficiency in languages besides those offered at Vicksburg. Students do not need seat time in order to achieve credit.
