SAT/PSAT Test Prep is underway at the high school.

Winter MAP testing has been completed. The first chart shows an achievement analysis from Fall to Winter of this school year.

- → As you can see by looking at the NWEA norms the amount of suspected growth at the high school level is minimal. This strengthens the need for interventions and supports, as well as exposure to rigorous curriculum, for our students who are struggling. If we are not intentional with these two success factors to help our struggling students, we are not putting them in positions to be successful. They will show little growth and make up minimal ground without interventions and exposure.
- → 9th Grade ELA met their growth target and scored above the grade level expectation.
- → The 9th Grade Math score was within 0.4 of the grade level norm.
- → 11th Grade ELA met their growth target and was within 0.2 of the grade level norm.
- $\rightarrow$  11th Grade Math was also within 0.2 of the grade level norm.

- → 10th Grade ELA has growth exceeding NWEA grade level norms.
- → 10th Grade ELA and Math have growth exceeding NWEA growth norms.
- → 11th Grade Math has growth exceeding NWEA growth norms
- → 11th Grade ELA did not hit the growth target of 224.95. However, that growth target is 0.55 higher than the grade level norm. The 11th Grade score of 224.4 was only 0.2 from the grade level target of 224.6.

We have made progress and I believe we will continue to make progress as the course and curriculum changes continue to be implemented.
