- Public Snap shot (the brochure) now known as the Student Success Brochure (SSB) contains the bold items, the top 2 indicators per district strategic pillar. A few SSB updates asked for:
 - Add the date stamp on the document
 - Color Banners for each pillar to match/align with the indicator in the brochure summary
 - Instead of date range – have the Season the brochure is updated (ie Spring or Fall)
- Logistics of delivering the SSB – ie when, where, how still being considered
- Target Audience – Goal for parents, community/industry, ie everyone
- Customer Service Metric – Not a great fit for the SSB but valuable – need good process for this
