Subject: Consider Approval to Apply for the 2025-2026 Remote Conferencing and Remote Homebound Waiver

Background Information: GISD has a student that requires Homebound services. The student underwent a major procedure in the prior school year. The student is under the care of Cook's Children's Hospital and GISD is working collaboratively with the student's doctors to design the most appropriate educational plan for the student.

The Texas Education Agency (TEA) requires board approval for the submission of a waiver for Remote Homebound Instruction. The student's ARD committee makes the decision and will consider whether the remote homebound instruction most appropriately meets the needs of the student.

Administrative Consideration: We would like for the Board to approve the District to apply for the 2025-2026 Remote Conferencing and Remote Homebound Waiver. These waivers are only granted in extremely severe medical circumstances, and waivers are submitted on a case by case basis.
