Mr. Stauder reported the desire to establish a one way traffic pattern for parents picking up at the Jr. High/HS. Chief Bland mentioned remarking crosswalks and other signals around the buildings. Mrs. Ellis suggested an end of day staggered

release of students at the Jr. High. Traffic management around the Jr. High/HS may be revised in order to smooth out the traffic flow.

Re: security Mrs. Ellis expressed a desire to add a CCTV camera to the Jr. High playground area.

Chief Bland requested a security review for bus drivers prior to any future training scenarios. Mr. Stauder mentioned they cover that annually as a refresher. Chief Bland mentioned the lighting on the buses go from yellow to red as the arm kicks out to remind the bus drivers to be careful about applying that when cars are near. Mr. Stauder is discussing the potential of stop arm cameras. Chief Bland said the flag control volunteers are doing a good job of controlling crosswalk areas.
