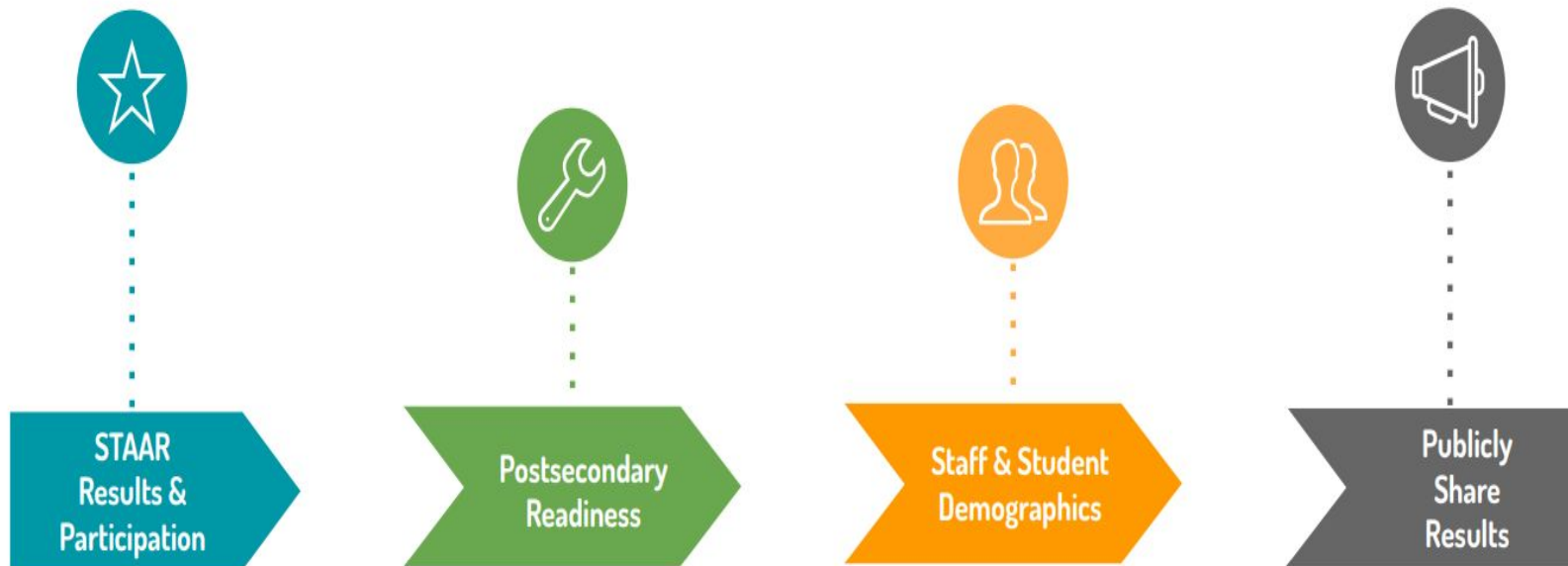

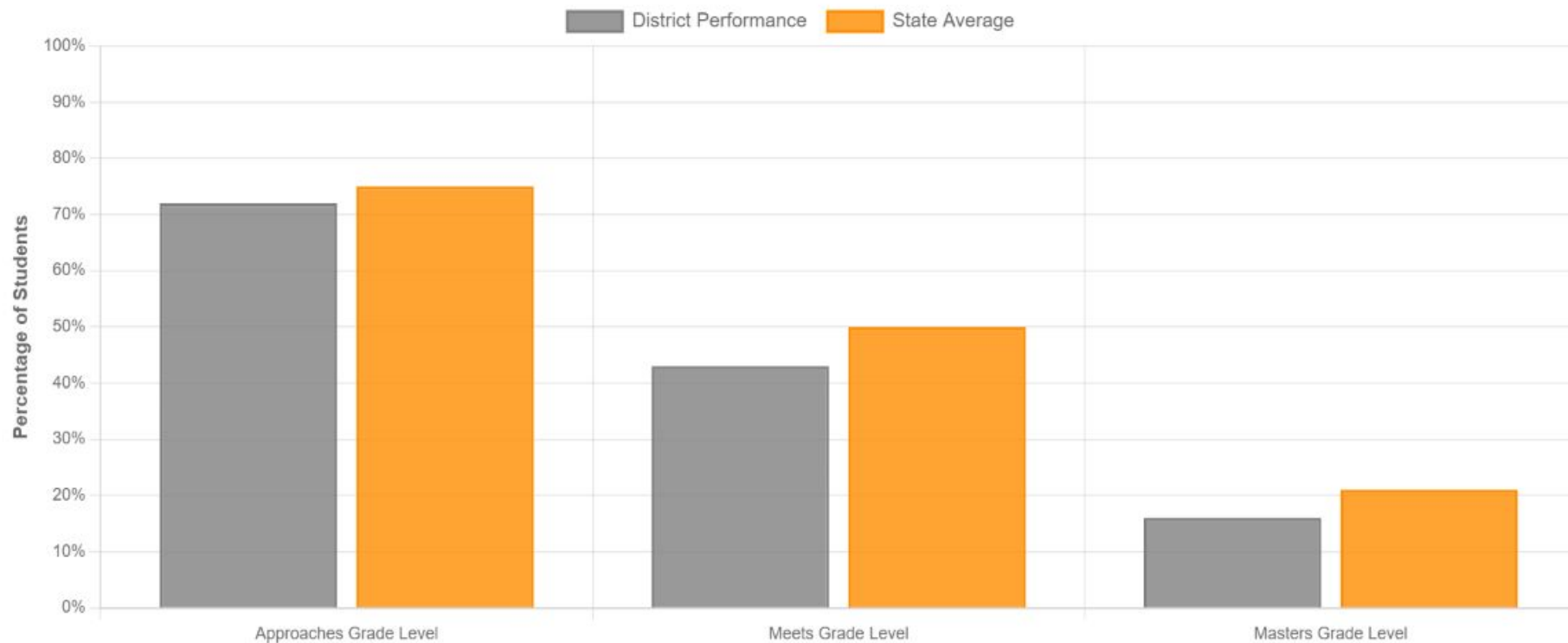

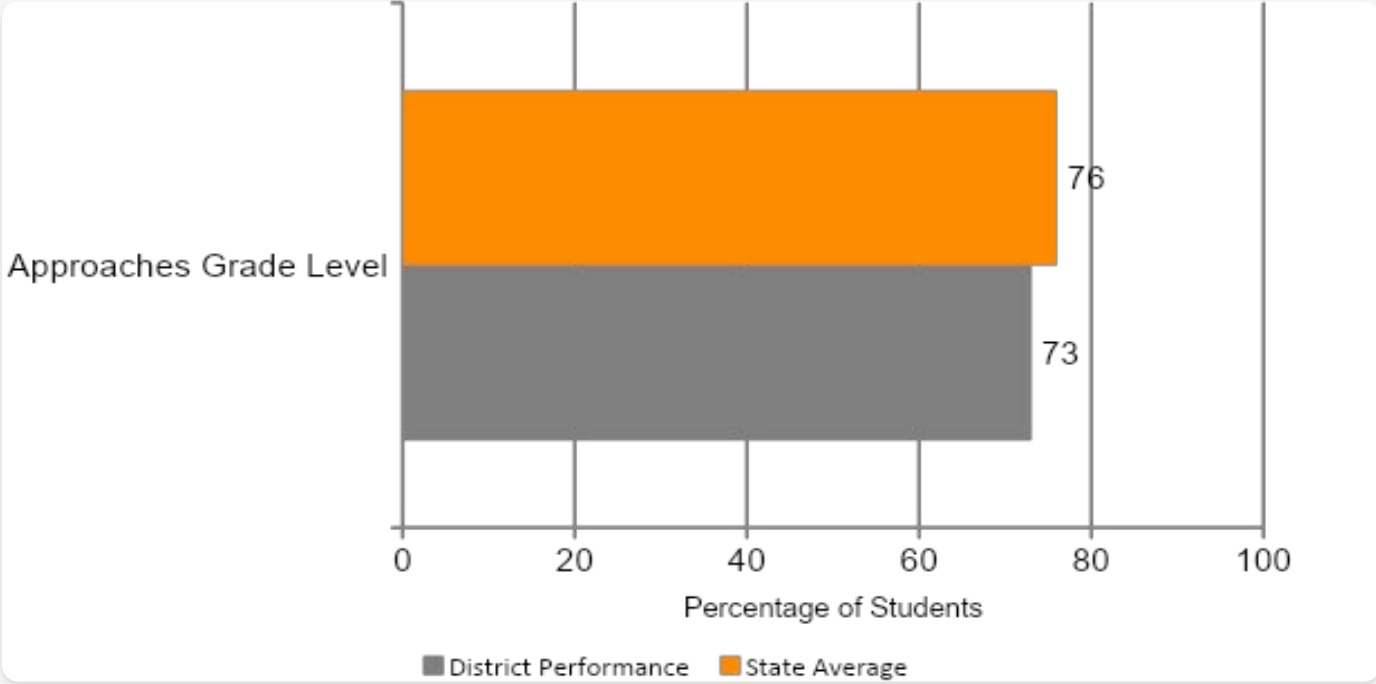


# STAAR Performance - All Grades 2025

## All Subjects - Performance Comparison



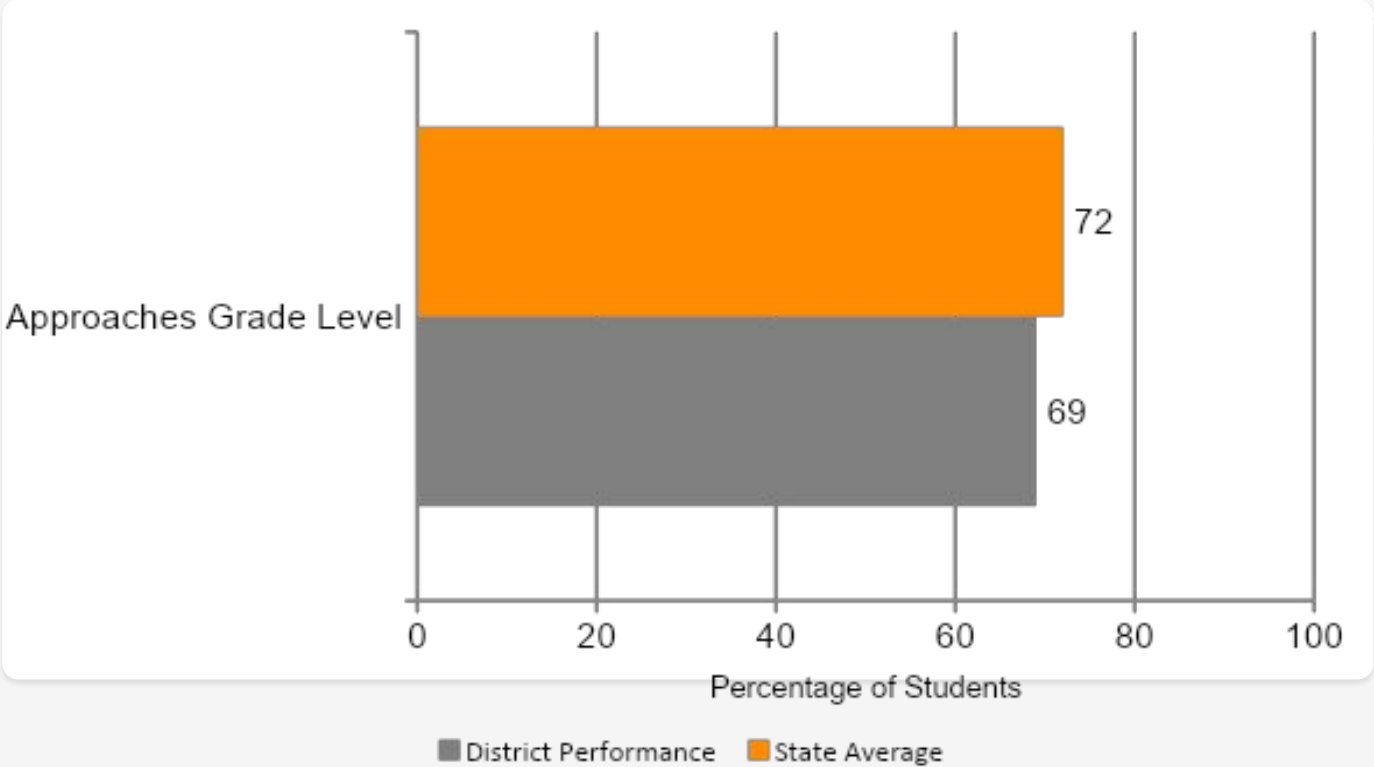
# 3-8 Reading Performance

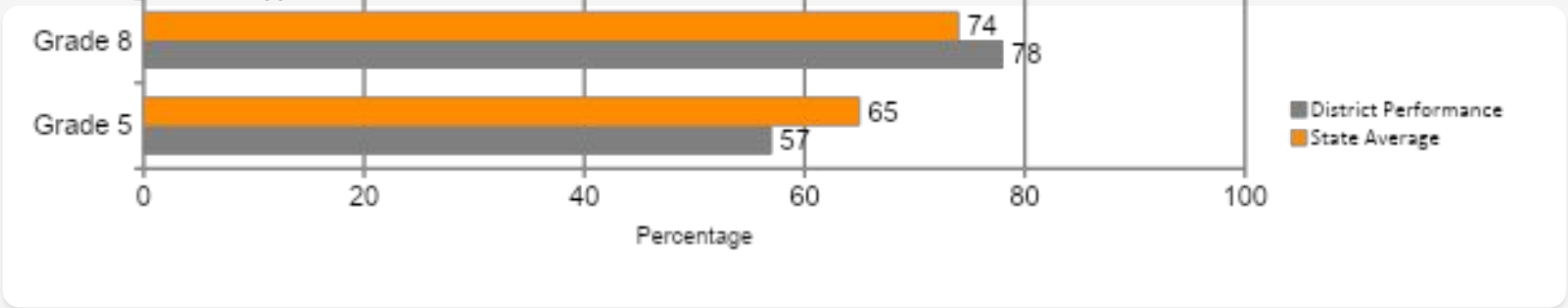
# 3-8 Mathematics Performance



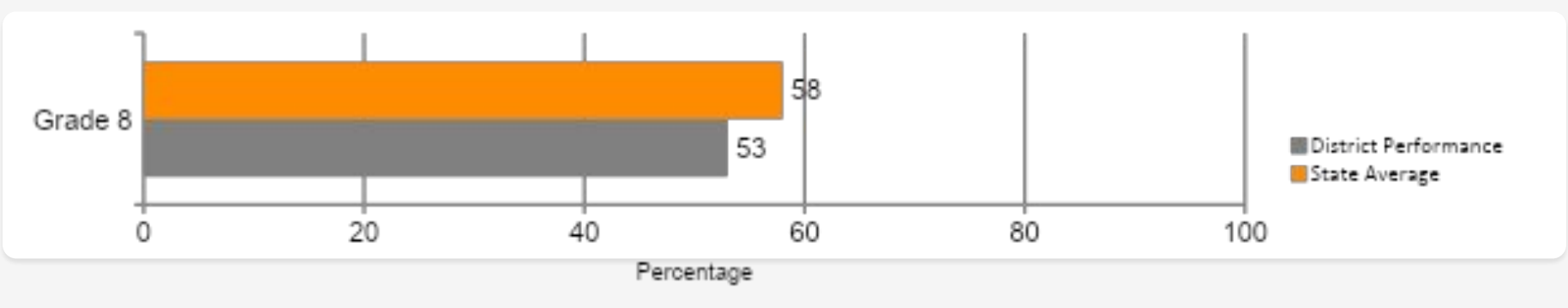

# At-Risk Student Performance

TEA (Texas Education Agency) "At-Risk" criteria identify **students needing extra support**, including those who failed to advance grades, performed poorly on assessments, are pregnant/parents, homeless, in foster care, chronically absent (over 10% of days), truant, or emergent bilingual, all aimed at **reducing dropout rates and improving academic outcomes**.

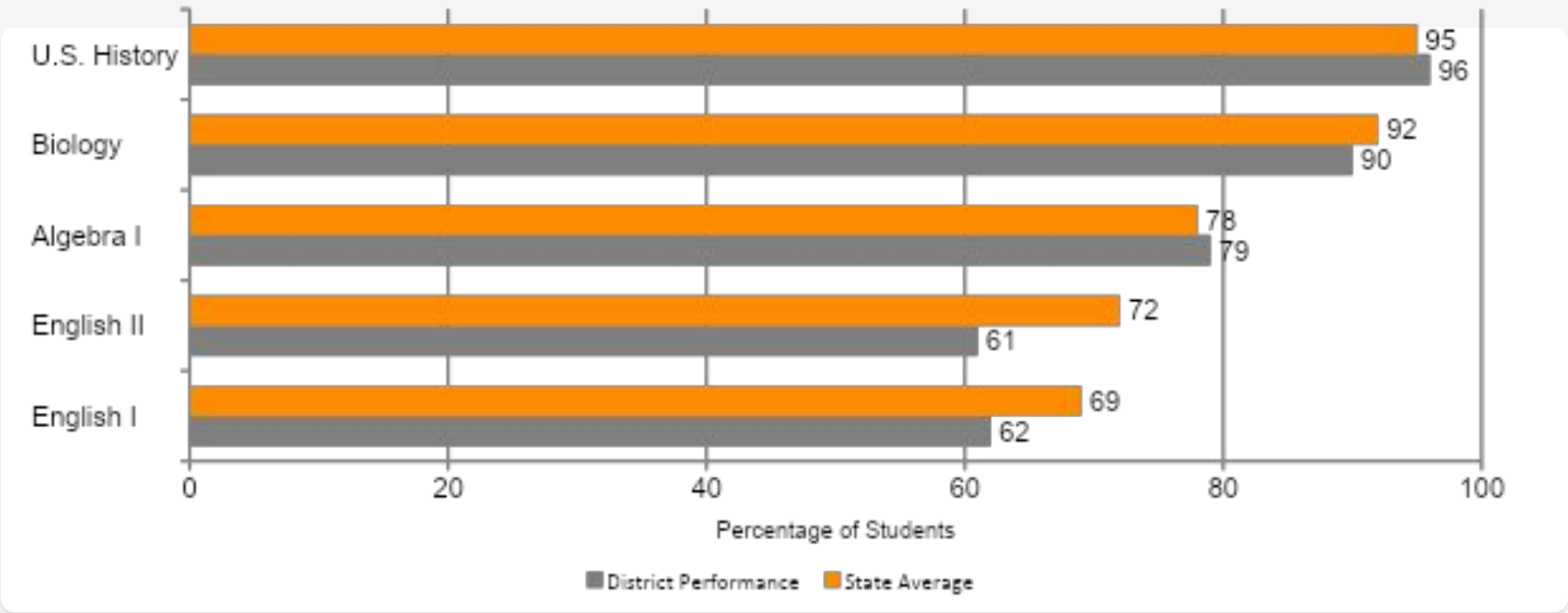

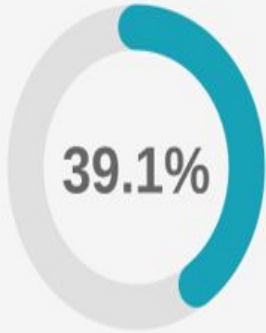

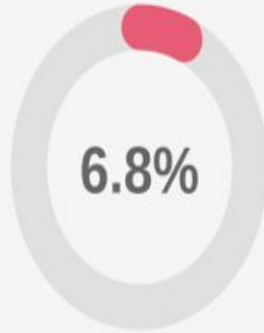

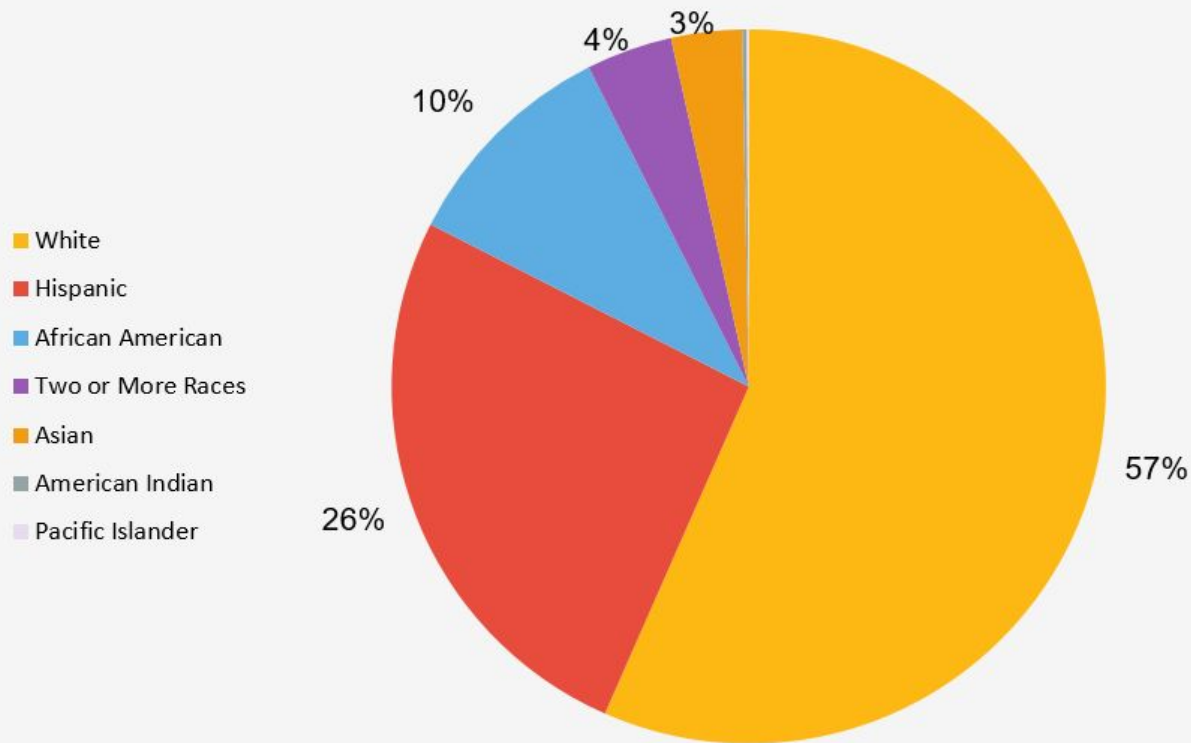

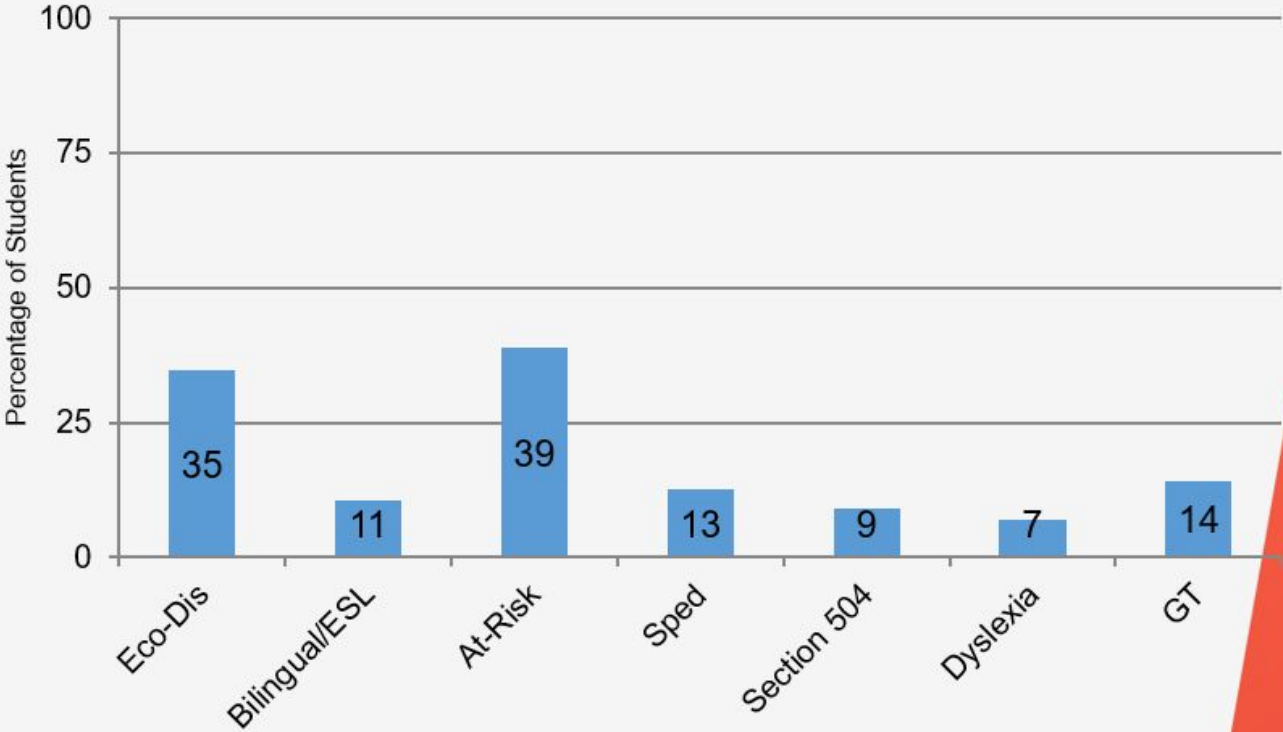

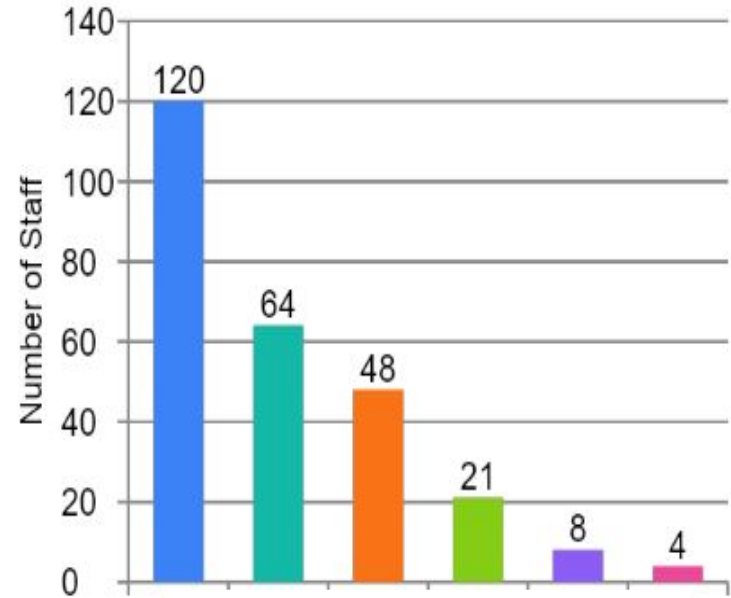

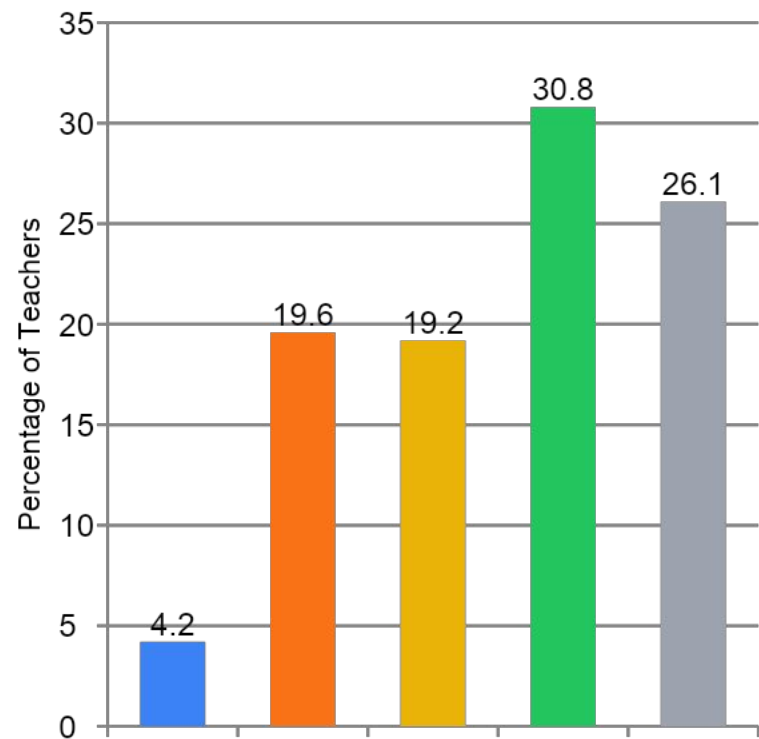
