## **Background Information and Rationale:**

Background Information and Rationale- All school systems, including school districts, open-enrollment charter schools, and districts of innovation, are required to identify and serve emergent bilingual (EB) students through bilingual education, which includes bilingual and ESL programs, per 19 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §89.1205. Pursuant to 19 TAC §89.1207(a)(1) and (b)(1), a school system that does not have the appropriately certified teachers for their required bilingual and/or ESL program(s) must apply to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) for a bilingual exception and/or ESL waiver. The approval of a bilingual exception and/or an ESL waiver shall be valid only during the school year for which it is granted.
