## **Updates & Events:**

- Summer picnics are in full swing! We have averaged 65 kids in attendance over the first two weeks. We
  are partnering with area businesses this summer to bring volunteers and donations to our picnics to
  build a sustainable model to continue this activity in future years and encourage community
  involvement. Our first two weeks have received sponsorship by Crosby Subway and Graphic
  Packaging. The June 26th picnic will be sponsored by Mid MN Federal Credit Union.
- Play week starts Monday, June 24th with auditions at 1:00pm for The Pied Piper. We will be offering
  two public performances of this production on Friday, June 28th at 6:00pm and Saturday, June 29th at
  2:00pm all in the Mayberry Auditorium. Admission to one of the performances is \$5 for adults, \$3 for
  students, and preschoolers attend for free.
- Jacob Wetterling Resource Center will be providing a free presentation titled "Smart Not Scared:
  Personal Safety Messages for Teens & Parents" on Wednesday, July 31st at 6:00pm. We are working
  on providing a free meal and potentially sibling care to make this event easier for families to attend.
