1. Campus staffing patterns. Secondary schools need a full time special education teacher who does not coach. Recommendation: Will hire a teacher who is passionate about services for special education students and who is an advocate for these kids.

2. BISD will collaborate with Cluster 5 for special education administration, oversight & hiring decisions. Cluster 5 will help advertise positions, develop training modules for all special education staff and assist staff with admin. of special Ed programs.

3. Campus staffing patterns will be examined to insure students needs as documented in the IEP are being met. IEPs are the foundation for special education students' study. IEPs will be followed. Need more training for mainstream teachers.
