Background Information

Midway ISD tracks student growth through three performance tools: Tango LION, IXL, and NWEA Map. The Assessments provide individual student progress data through Beginning of Year, Middle of Year, and End of Year Assessments. Administrators, Specialists, and Teachers utilize the data to focus on individual student growth areas.

NWEA MAP Growth, used as the district reading screener, is a nationally normed, adaptive test that determines a student's current level of achievement throughout the school year. The platform utilizes the RiT score to demonstrate a student's current level of achievement and track individual student growth throughout the year. Both IXL and Tango LION, the district math screeners, measure individual student mastery of the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills throughout the year and report whether a student is achieving grade-level expectations based on the current level of content covered.

Dr. Odajima will present the data captured for Midway students from the past three school years, as well as the current BOY data.
