<p>Terms of Suspension, pg. 3</p>	<p>Current Language:</p> <p><u>TERMS OF SUSPENSION</u></p> <p>First violation: Suspension from participation in extracurricular contests for 30 calendar days. Days in the month of July do not count in this 30 calendar days.</p> <p>Second violation: Suspension from participation in extracurricular contests for 60 calendar days and forfeit all awards earned during the current activity. Days in the month of July do not count in this 60 calendar days.</p> <p>Third violation: Suspension from participation in all extracurricular contests for one calendar year. Days in the month of July do not count in this calendar year.</p> <p>Fourth violation: Suspension from participation for the remainder of his/her eligibility at Midwest Central Middle School.</p> <p>The total number of violations is cumulative.</p> <p>Updated Language:</p> <p>TERMS OF SUSPENSION</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● First Violation: Suspension from participation in extracurricular contests for 30 calendar days. This suspension will be served during the current Illinois Elementary School Association sport in which the student is participating, or the next IESA contest or sport in which the student participates. ● Second Violation: Suspension from participation in extracurricular contests for 60 calendar days. This suspension will be served during the current IESA sport in which the student is participating, or the next IESA contest or sport in which the student participates. ● Third Violation: Suspension from participation in all extracurricular contests for one calendar year. ● Fourth Violation: Suspension from participation in extracurricular activities for the remainder of the student's eligibility 	<p>New language reflects more accurate consequences for athletic code violations for misconduct.</p> <p>Removal of the wording that the month of July does not count is necessary since IESA softball now begins in July.</p>
