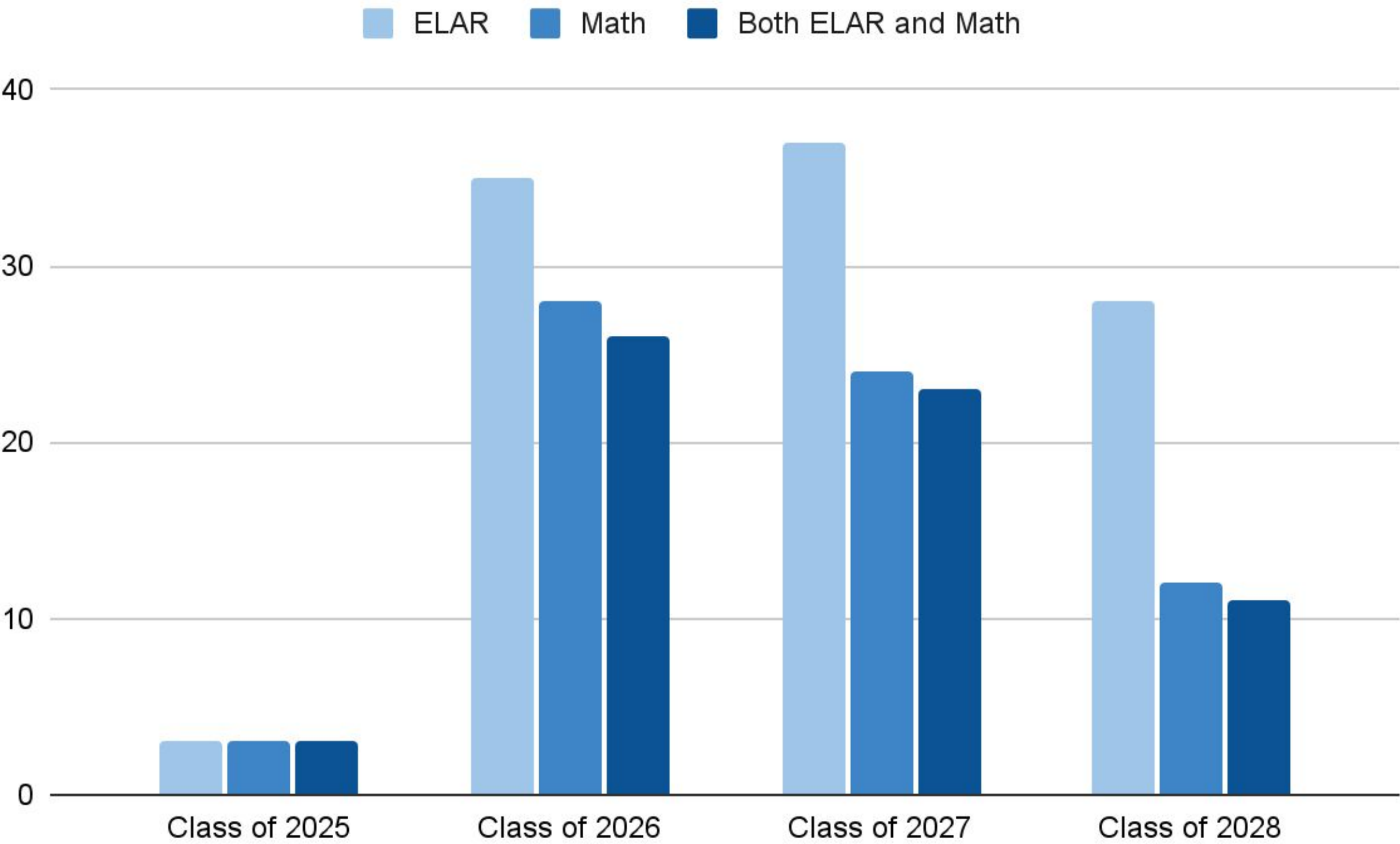

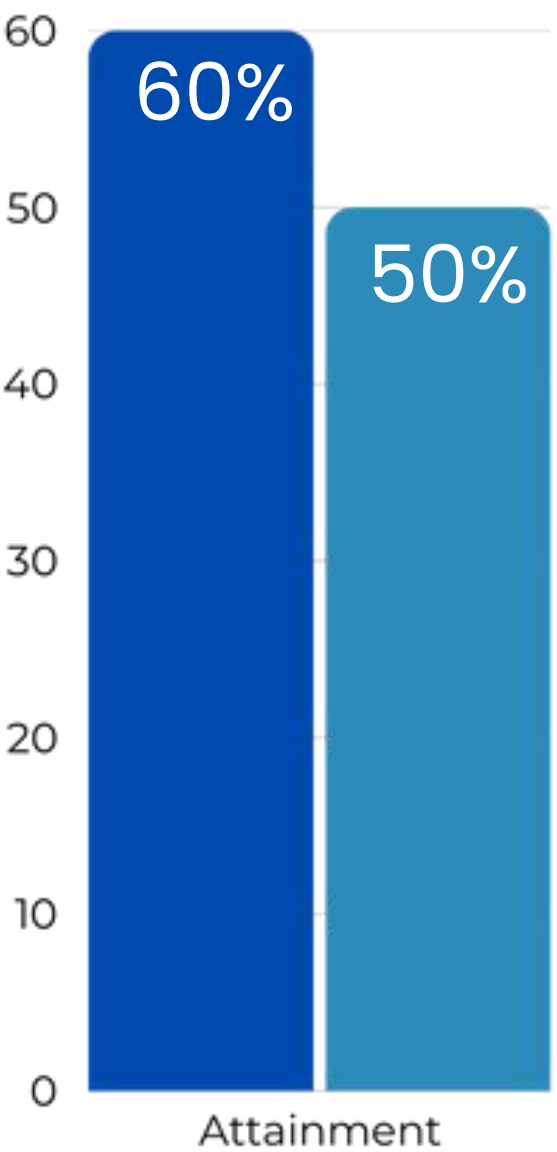
Access

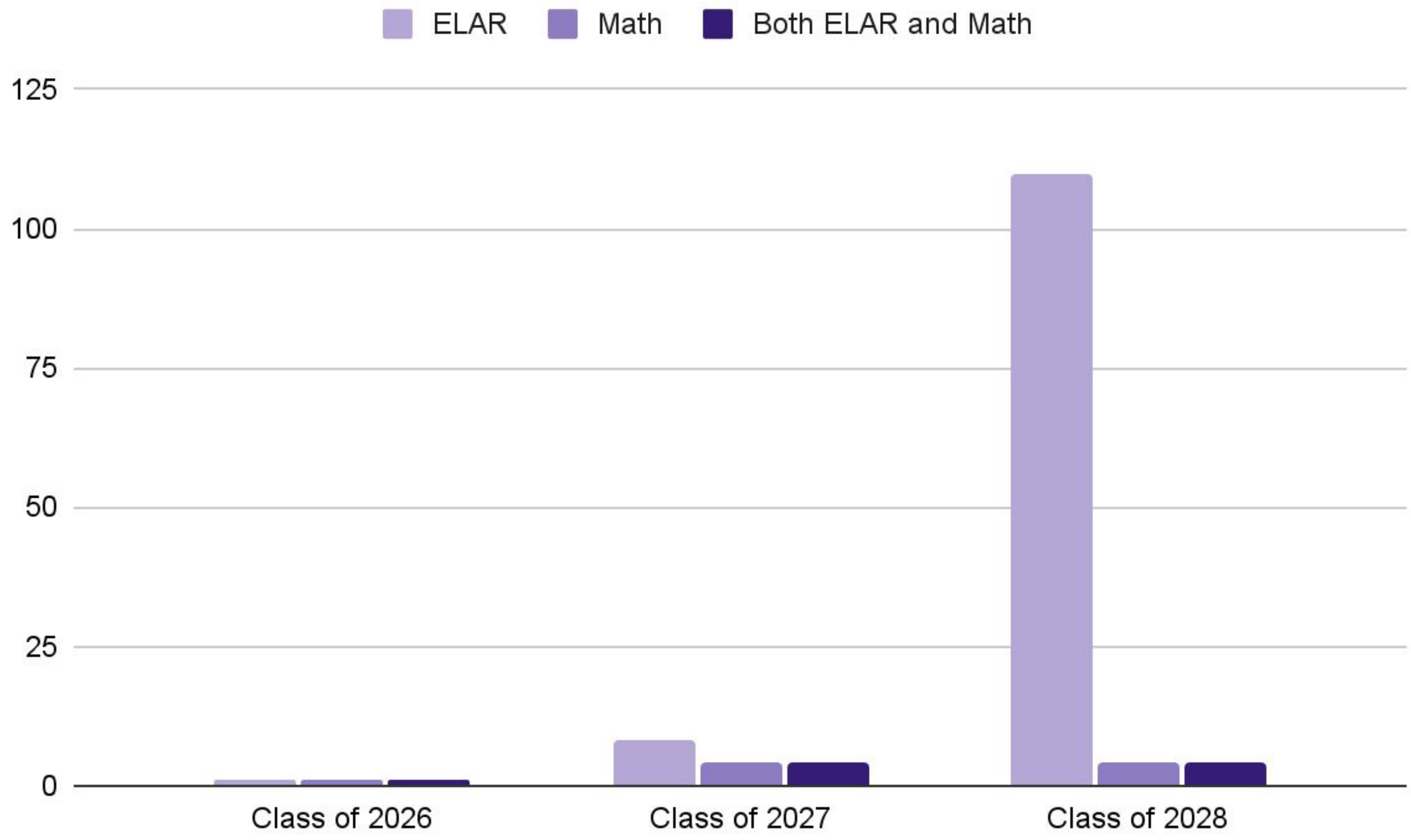
