As we discussed potential capital project work for the summer of 2014, which included full accessibility of Whittier school and the pilot temperature/climate project (23 unit ventilators across the District), I inquired of our architectural firm, STR Partners, LLC, if any of this work could be funded through grants. Jennifer Costanzo, the architect from STR who oversees our work, investigated and indicated that the only possibility of grant funding is through the State, under the umbrella of a School Maintenance Project Grant program (Round 2), which is a matching grant up to the amount of \$50,000. The elements of the summer 2014 work that would qualify are the temperature controls for the Early Childhood classrooms (2) as well as the other pilot climate control classrooms (Rooms: 120, 216, 218 and 315). The reason is the temperature controls in these rooms are in poor condition and the original components are in need of replacement. Further the existing casework in these rooms is in poor condition with delaminating plastic laminate and the wood casework that is original to the building has deteriorated exposing the wood and causing further damage.

In order to apply for consideration of this Maintenance Project Grant, the Board of Education must first approve a Life/Safety Amendment which Jennifer has prepared for us citing these two violations. Attached to this memo are two documents, which accompany the Life/Safety Amendment: (1) Violation and Recommendation Schedule; and (2) Schedule of Recommended Work Items and Estimated Costs. Once the Board approves the amendment, it will be sent into the State; however, the contents of the amendment become the basis for the construction of the grant application, which Jennifer will assist District 97 in completing. District 97 will then need a motion/resolution by the Board of Education to comply with the grant application requirements, and then District 97 will need to submit such application by the established deadline of February 28, 2014.

Given this extremely tight timeline, you provided the Board with an explanation in your Board Report for the February 11, 2014 meeting in order to be respectful of the Board's process of reviewing an item at one meeting and approving at the next subsequent meeting. I appreciate the Board's consideration of accepting your explanation at the February 11, 2014 in anticipation of their approval of this Life/Safety Amendment and motion for subsequent submission of the Maintenance Project Grant.
