## 1 school funded in 2008-09 Holmes

#### 6 schools funded in 2009-10

Beye, Hatch, Lincoln, Longfellow, Mann & Whittier

#### 5 schools funded in 2010-11

Beye, Holmes, Irving, Longfellow, & Mann





## **D97 Actual Savings To Date**

District Savings to Date on Lunchrooms (5 schools) \$19,734.99

+

District Savings to Date on Paper (8 schools) \$6,249.00

**TOTAL SAVINGS = \$25,983.99** 



## D97 Savings To Date Reusable Lunchrooms

1 school switched to a reusable lunchroom in 2008-2009 4 schools switched to reusable lunchrooms in 2009-2010

Savings of approx \$3,950 per school per year

Actual District savings 2009-10 \$1,087.66 Actual District savings 2010-11 \$18,647.33

DISTRICT SAVINGS TO DATE ON 5 LUNCHROOMS \$19,734.99

## Reusable Lunchroom

#### 100% Grant Funded:

- Reusable Trays and Utensils
- Tray carts, drying racks, etc.
- Dishwasher
- Buckets and other supplies for sorting (compost, recycle, trash)

### **District Savings:**

 No longer purchase disposable trays and spork packets





## D97 Savings To Date White Paper Purchasing

#### **Use Both Sides – Reduce Paper Waste**

- 6 schools were funded by DCEO in 2009-2010 and required by the grant to use both sides of white paper
- 3 of these schools saw a significant savings (they purchased much less paper the year they had the grant than the previous year)

Actual Savings in 2009-10 (compared to amount purchased in 2008-09)

Lincoln \$3,312 Mann \$2,070 Whittier \$4,140

DISTRICT SAVINGS TO DATE ON PAPER (8 schools) \$6,249.00



## **Paper - Use Both Sides**

#### 100% Grant Funded:

- Stackable trays for sorting paper in the classrooms
- Smart Boards
- Dry erase boards

### **District Savings:**

 No longer purchase as much paper because paper gets used on both sides before being recycled Please Remember We Are Aiming to be a Zero Waste School:

## D97 Opportunities for Saving Hand Dryers

### **Replace Paper Towels with Hand Dryers**

6 schools have ordered hand dryers to date (for many but not all bathrooms in each school).

Savings of \$2,075 in paper towels per school per year if switch is made to hand dryers in <u>all</u> bathrooms.

\$2,075 x 6 schools = District savings each year of \$12,450

\*19 dryers installed last year, 41 being installed this year



## D97 Opportunities for Saving Improved Paper Use

### 2-Sided Copy Policy

3 schools were able to save significantly on paper purchasing last year (an average of \$3,000 per school).

If the other 5 Zero Waste schools were to implement similar changes, the District might save an additional \$11,000

Imagine the savings if all the District schools used both sides of the paper!

Other D97 school zero waste initiatives helping to reduce waste and save money:


- Digital Backpacks
