PACE teachers are participating in Amplify training refreshers this month to prepare for our DIBELS Middle of the Year (MOY) assessments during the first half of January. Zoom sessions (similar to PLCs, but are all teachers) begin in December to discuss course material for the AK Reads courses and share out intervention strategies for families.
