

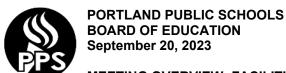

#### **Committee Discussions**

## Whitaker Adams Property

Director Hollands introduced the proposed Albina Sports Complex, noting that the proposed project encompasses various athletic and community components that would be accessible to Portland Public Schools students. The project is expected to receive funding from a combination of private and public sources. He highlighted Phillip Walden, who was the founder of the Albina Sports Program.

He noted that although he is affiliated with the Albina Sports Complex project, it has been vetted for a conflict of interest and found to not be a conflict because there is no financial benefit to him due to his volunteer role at both organizations.

Two friendly amendments were offered and accepted which would update the resolution to include Board approval of the final lease agreement, and to reflect that the proposal also includes Portland Parks and Recreation's property, which would need to be negotiated separately.

The committee voted to move the resolution with added amendments to the full Board for consideration.

## Jefferson High School

Staff: Steve Effros, Dan Jung, and Keisha Locklier

Staff provided an update on the Jefferson High School modernization, including background and options considered for a swing site for the construction process, plans to support the transition, and the unique challenge of preserving the historical 1909 portion of the building.

The Committee asked questions and provided feedback. There was discussion regarding the enrollment impacts of relocating the school community to the Marshall site, the middle-college program, the value engineering process, and the impact of pausing the project to consider alternative designs that might keep students on site. It was noted that it could be detrimental to the project to stop the process at this point because of the increased costs in prolonging it. Staff stated that they will continue to work on alternative swing site location options that are closer to the Jefferson community.
