 Report on Month of August.  
 September 2018 monthly report

<p>Objective #1.1 Improve English Proficiency</p>	<p>During the month of July, Mrs. Sunchild and I did pre-screening (Letters, numbers, colors, Phonemic Awareness, handling books) on our 15 students.</p> <p>During the last week of August, we started the preschool OWLs curriculum in the classroom. I have read three books each week. We are teaching six concept words each week! Each week we are going through a new letter, number, emotion, color, and 6 concept words related to the theme.</p> <p>During the first two weeks of school we focused on learning rules, routines, procedures, and the beginning of unit one in the OWLs curriculum (friends.) The students were introduced to classroom, classmates, and a few staff members at Rocky Boy Schools.</p> <p>I found various materials to hang in the classroom. I purchased a lot of things off teacherpayteacher.com that would enhance my students learning in the classroom! These materials are hung in the room to help students memorize ABCs, numbers, shapes, colors, ect. I printed and laminated a lot of material to ensure my classroom was ready for my 15 upcoming pre-k students!</p>
<p>Objective #1.2 Improve progress in learning English</p>	<p>In mid-July, we pre-screened our students. We accepted fifteen students based on our pre-assessment.</p>

Other Duties:

	<p>We used the OWL curriculum to screen the students. In late August, I used the data to place my students in 3 tiers (Benchmark, strategic, and intensive). I am working on getting all students in strategic! We currently have 6 students in the intensive tier for literacy. In math, we have 8 students in the intensive tier. The remaining students are in the strategic tier for both literacy and math.</p> <p>By the end of the year, I want the majority of the students to be in the benchmark tier and ready for Kindergarten.</p> <p>I have been scaffolding learning objectives throughout the week. I have been using multiple different ways to teach materials. I am assessing students' knowledge every two weeks. I plan on using my data to direct my instruction.</p> <p>We have sent Friday homework folders each week with additional materials to aid learning. The first month of school we have just sent homework home related to writing their names. Once we have our September family fun night, I plan on sending books, ABC, and number worksheets home to encourage repetition, and attainment of materials.</p>
Objective #1.3 Increase proficiency attainment	I am using my data to keep my students that are proficient according to the OWLs curriculum to be advanced by the end of pre-K. I will be assessing students bi-weekly and quarterly to track their attainment.
Objective 2.1 Cree Language Instruction	Val and I have been aligning our lesson plans to teach the same materials in the different languages.
Objective 3.1 Preschool children Enrollment	As of August 22, 2018, first day of school we have 15 full time students enrolled in the pre-k Cree immersion school and 3 alternates

Objectives 3.2 Developmental and Cognitive Screen	Screening for 15 full time students will be held in October 8,9, and,10 2018 administered Bear Paw co-op.
Objective 3.3 Coordination Contacts	In the month of September, four Head Start teachers observed Kindergarten for five days
