Below you will find information regarding the School Nutrition mid-year budget update for the 2024-25 fiscal year (FY2025). We appreciate the collaboration with our budget managers to prepare these budget updates.

## **School Nutrition Fund**

The budget, as presented at the April 8, 2025 school board study session, results in a FY2025 year-end fund balance of \$918,608. This fund balance is an increase of \$357,000 from the original FY2025 budget. At this point, we believe this is a realistic picture of the budget as we:

- incorporate the impact of federal and state funding; and
- incorporate actual staffing and food costs along with revised projections in other budget areas.
