This property was sold at a Sheriff's Sale on November 3, 2009 pursuant to delinquent tax collection suit number 429-01602-2008. There were no bidders and the property was struck off to the Collin County Community College District for itself and on behalf of the other taxing jurisdictions.

The property's most recent value according to the Appraisal District is \$21,200.00. The property was struck off for the total judgment amount, \$20,349.11 which includes taxes, penalties and interest, road assessment lien, costs of court, and costs of sale.

Pursuant to the Texas Property Tax Code the court costs and costs of sale must be paid first out of the proceeds of a resale. The remainder would be distributed to the taxing jurisdictions prorata. Those costs total \$6,955.90. A breakdown of amounts each taxing entity will receive is enclosed.

In addition, the County has a road assessment lien on the property which will be extinguished by this sale. Pursuant to the Texas Property Tax Code, this lien is only paid if there are excess proceeds after all entities are paid the full amount of taxes due.

If all taxing jurisdictions agree to accept \$7,800.00 for the property, the property may be sold for that amount. Each jurisdiction must execute the deed.
