Agenda Item: Division 22 Standards for 24-25 Item 1.D.3

Purpose of this Agenda Item: Informational Report to Board

The Division 22 Standards are the requirements that the Oregon Legislature or the State Board of Education has determined must be met in order to be a standard school district. These requirements are codified in Chapter 581, Division 22 of Oregon Administrative Rules and can be found on the Secretary of State's Oregon Administrative Rules Database.

Compliance with the Division 22 Standards ensures every student in Oregon public schools is provided with a standard, or baseline, level of service.

In November of each year, districts are required to report on compliance with the Division 22 Standards for the preceding school year, both to ODE and to the local school board and community. Making the report in November allows for an accurate assessment of a district's compliance during a given academic year.
