Summary:	Due to the ongoing pipe failures and sediment clogging equipment on the second and third floors of the campus, the administration recommends using contingency funds in the contract to allow the construction process to proceed while school is in session. This adds cost for additional valves, labor, and materials to isolate sections of the second and third floor piping system for replacement while other sections remain active LLCI has constructed walls to maintain separation between the campus areas and workers on the second and third floors. The work is proceeding efficiently without disruption to the campus. Under this plan, various sections will be replaced from October through March when work will stop for the testing season and will resume in June.
